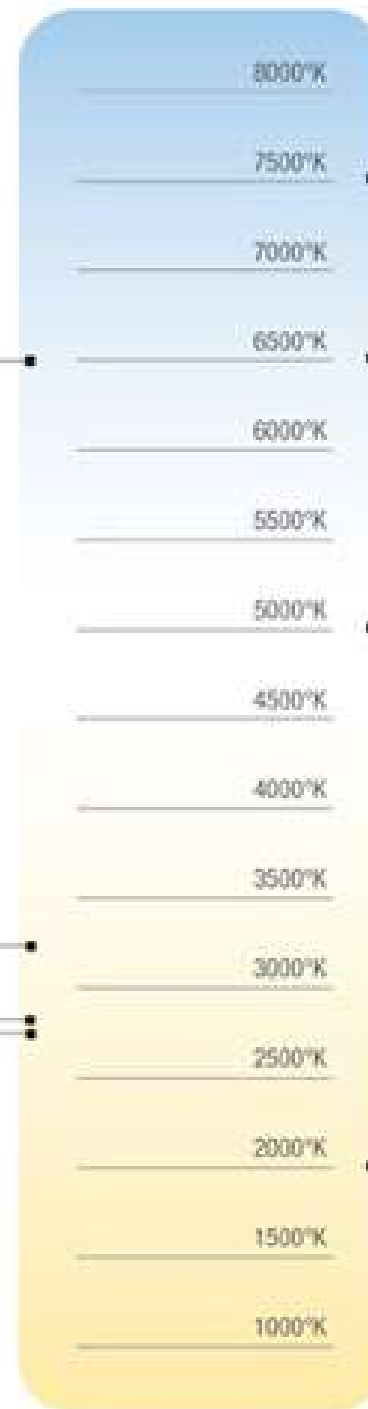

An overcast sky casts a bluish light measuring approximately 6,500 to 7,500 degrees Kelvin.



Sunlight at Midday 5500°K

The whitest light of all measures approximately 5,500 degrees Kelvin.



Candle Light 2000°K

The warmest light source of all measures around 2,000 degrees Kelvin.
